Your local Facility will provide dedicated areas for the disposal of waste, these include:-

- Green Waste
- Construction & Demolition Waste
- Steel
- Tyres
- Resource Recovery Area
- General Waste

It is important for people to separate their waste prior to coming to the Waste Management Facility. To avoid any doubt, the table below provides a list of what can and cannot be accepted at Council's Waste Management Facilities. A map of all the new facilities is available on Council's website.



- Residential waste
- Garden (green) waste
- Scrap metal
- Concrete (clean)
- Tyres
- eWaste
- Waste car oil
- Gas cylinders
- Cardboard
- Plastics
- Furniture & mattresses
- Chemical containers - (DrumMuster)
- Small amounts of building or demolition waste.



- Asbestos containing materials
- Large quantities of building or demolition waste
- Liquid and semi-liquid wastes
- Mixed demolition waste (e.g. mixed concrete, soil and other materials)
- Regulated wastes as prescribed by legislation
- Large quantities of manufactured timber products (timber, chipboard, etc.)
- Deceased animals/livestock
- Contaminated soil.
